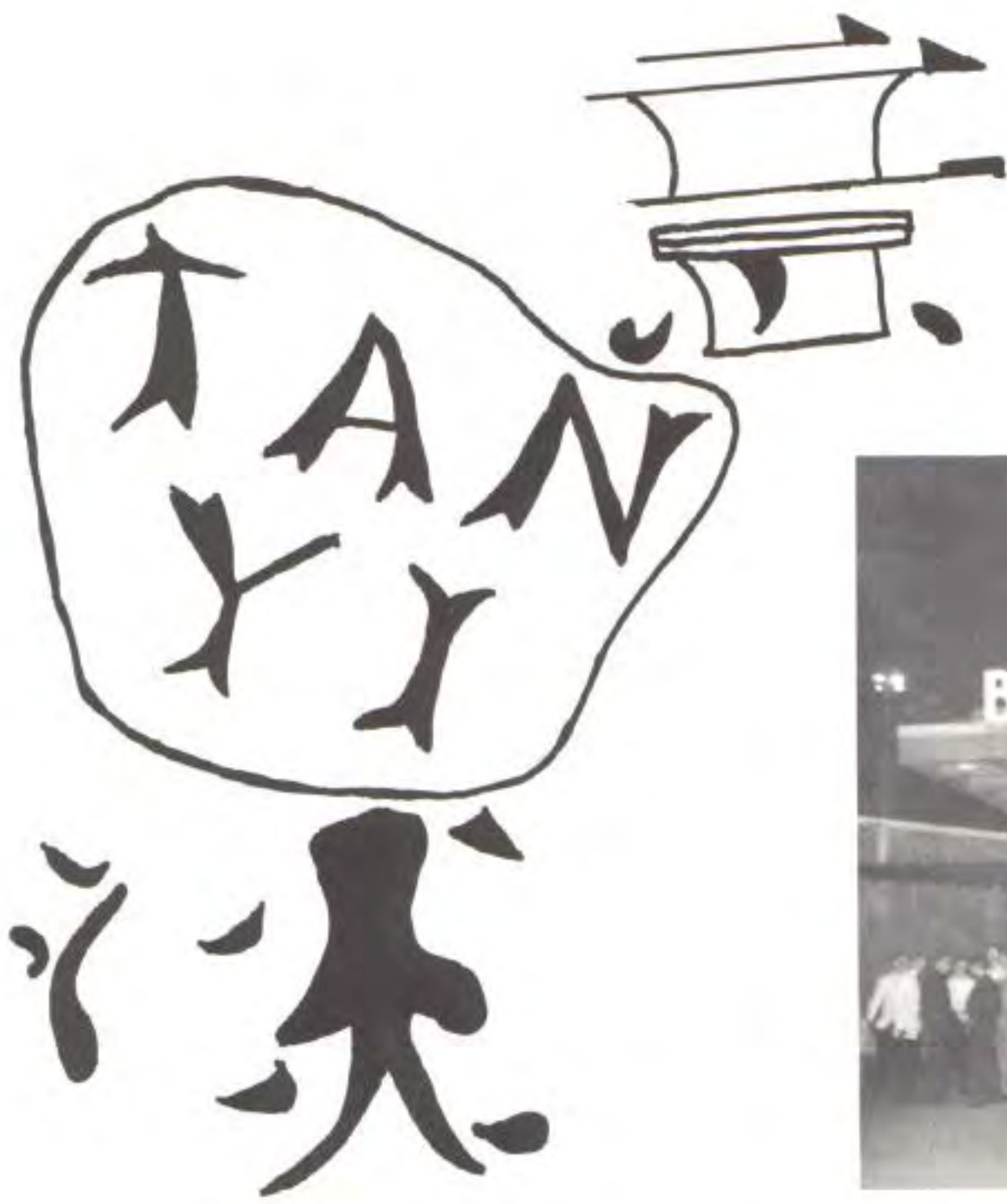

Stanard presented the graduating class to Russell Congdon, who conferred the diplomas.
